- **Big Brothers Big Sisters of Kentuckiana** facilitates meaningful, monitored mentoring between adult volunteers and children. Serving Grayson and Hardin Counties.
- **Breckinridge-Grayson Programs** provides students and their families with essential basic hygiene supplies and increase family engagement in early childhood education. Serving Grayson and Breckinridge Counties.
- **CASA of the Heartland** provides children in the Hardin County court system with trained volunteer advocates who care for their best interests and help them find safe, permanent, and loving homes. Serving Hardin County.
- **Cloverport Independent School District** the *FRYSC Cleaning Closet* increases access to basic hygiene supplies and the *Career Jump Start* program supports career-focused initiatives for students. Serving Irvington, Breckinridge County.
