



Read Tutor Mentor: Application for Funding Background Checks

Through Read Tutor Mentor, caring volunteers working with students of all ages have the power to help kids boost academic achievement and put youth on track towards a bright future. United Way of Central Kentucky is committed to assisting non-profits in their volunteer recruitment efforts for those local programs which provide reading, tutoring or mentoring support to children in our community.

Thanks to a sponsorship from Jarred K. Butler, State Farm, United Way is now also able to provide financial support to cover the cost of background checks for these volunteers. Funded programs are encouraged to use this as a tool to remove barriers to volunteer recruitment and placement. Funding will be awarded through mini-grants. Eligible programs may submit an application to be reviewed by the United Way of Central Kentucky Community Investment Team, with funding decisions being determined by the United Way of Central Kentucky Board of Directors.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Program must utilize volunteers to provide either reading support, tutoring support, or mentoring to children.
- Must be either a school supported program or a 501(c)3 non-profit in good standing with the IRS and Kentucky Secretary of State.
- Program must provide services to children and youth in at least one of the following five counties: Hardin, Breckinridge, Grayson, LaRue, and Meade.
- United Way of Central Kentucky funded and non-funded agencies are all eligible.



May 26th:
Application released to programs.

June 30th:
Applications due to UWCK office with copy emailed to impact@unitedwayck.org

July:
CIT review of application and deliberation.

August 25th:
Funding decision made by UWCK Board of Directors.

September 5th:
Approved programs notified and funding awarded.
